- Registration Process
 - Who would certify the applicant?
 - What areas would be accessible to him?
 - What rights (view, edit, upload) are available to the applicant?
- SC may develop a strategy
- More help text may be provided on the registration screen

- User name
- Password
- Personal information
- Institution
- Contact details
- Secret question

- Encourage other Member States to be visible in this area
- Develop some text to help Member States to upload their pages
- Nomination of country coordinators to maintain NNRP
- Training of country coordinators
